Ambassador Luciano Mazza de Andrade was born in 1970. He is a career diplomat who joined the Brazilian diplomatic service in 1994. Prior to his appointment as Ambassador-designate of Brazil to Singapore, Luciano Mazza occupied the position of Director of the Department of Science, Technology, Innovation and Intellectual Property at the Ministry of External Affairs of Brazil, covering the areas of science, technology & innovation, intellectual property, and digital policy cooperation.

He holds a Bachelor's degree in Law from the University of São Paul, Brazil and a Master of Laws (LLM) in European Law from the London School of Economics and Political Science, United Kingdom. He also defended his thesis on the Southern Common Market's (MERCOSUR) institutions at the Brazilian Diplomatic Academy.

He was previously posted, in various capacities, to the Brazilian embassies in the United Kingdom, Australia, Portugal, as well as to the Brazilian Mission to the European Union in Brussels, and to the Brazilian Permanent Delegation to the Latin American Integration Association (ALADI) and MERCOSUR in Montevideo, Uruguay. He has worked extensively with trade and regional integration issues, including as Head of the Division for Extra-Regional Trade Negotiations and as General Coordinator for WTO Dispute Settlement, in Brasília.
